Meet The Families



Our residents are nominated to us from our partnering homeless shelters in Jackson County, Ga and surrounding counties. The resident has recently transitioned into housing for a better future. Day one, you'll join Rooted Interiors staff on a home visit to to learn about the families needs, wishes and likes. You'll measure and take photos of the spaces.



Space Plan & Design

Interior Designers (Design Warriors) volunteer to create a families home. Based on the home visit, during day two and three, you'll develop a floor plan for each room and create mood/concept boards of your design ideas.



Source & Repurpose

This is the fun part - getting creative with using as much of our donated inventory as you can. Day four - six, you'll source products from our warehouse and you'll purchase the items, within the project budget we provide to you, that haven't been donated to us but that is needed for your design.

Day seven - nine, staff and our Rooted Warriors will prep and refinish the selected items from our warehouse while we wait for the new items to be delivered. We'll pack and prepare for tomorrow's moving day.



Rooting Day (Reveal Day)



Day 10 is the day our family can start planting roots and calling their place HOME!

Before they do, our Rooted Warriors help you with creating the home- placing furniture, hanging curtains and art, making beds, etc. At the end of the day, we welcome the family home with love!





What to expect as a Rooted Design Warrior

Day One

- Home Visit - 2 Hours

Day Two - Three

- Develop Floor Plan & Design Plan - 4 Hours

Day Four

- Source Items From Warehouse - 4 Hours

Day Five - Six

- Source & Purchase New Items - 2 - 4 Hours

Day Seven

- Finalize Plan With Staff + 2nd Warehouse Visit (If Needed). - 3 Hours

Day Eight - Nine

- Staff & Rooted Warriors Will Prep Furniture & Receive Deliveries - Take A Break
- Staff & Rooted Warriors Will Start Packing & Loading Moving Truck - Take Another Break

Day Ten

- Review Packing List With Staff - 1 Hour
- Rooting Day - 8 - 10 Hours

TOTAL VOLUNTEER TIME COMMITMENT: 24 - 28 HOURS



How to Sow the Seeds of Style & Stability

For each home, we try to provide:

- Living area with seating, coffee table, side table(s), lamps, large rug, curtains, and art.
- Kitchen/dining space where everyone in the family can share a meal together.
- Home organization area - Whiteboard/bulletin board/catch all space.
- Each bedroom with bed, nightstand(s), lamp, rug, curtains, and art.
- Mom/guardian room to have a space just for her/him - desk/vanity/occasional chair.
- Desk and desk chair for every school-aged child. Reading corner for younger children.
- Bathroom with storage spaces, shower curtain, and art where possible.
- Include family photos to personalize the space.
- For safety and liability concerns, please do not use these items in your design: candles, heavy wall art or mirrors, or tall shelving
